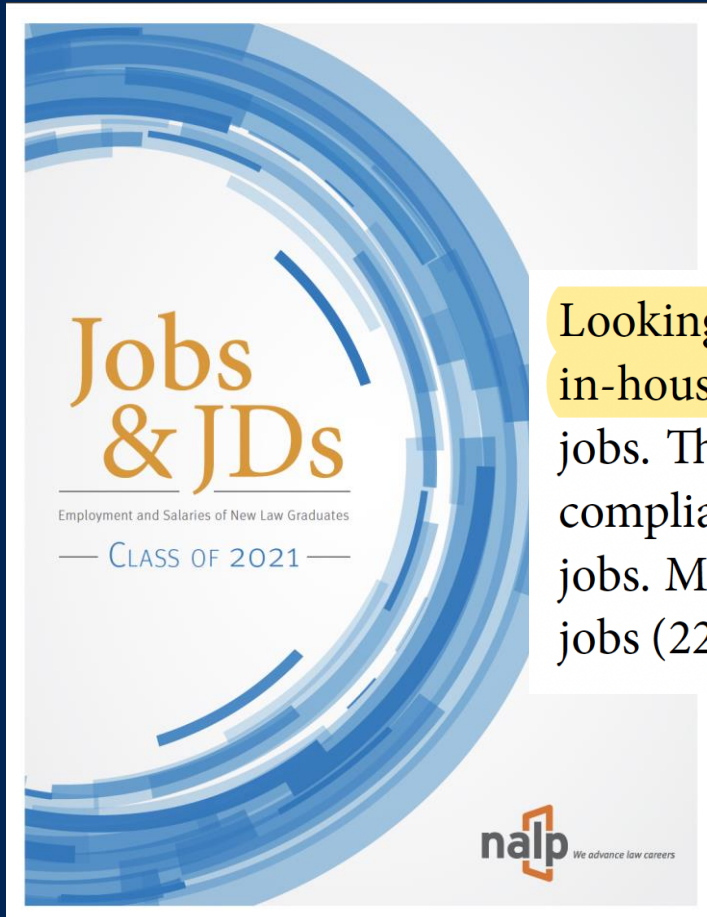

Why launch an in-house counsel course?



Looking at specific job types reveals that jobs as corporate in-house lawyers numbered 672 — or about 19% of business jobs. The second-most reported type of job in business was compliance, representing 9% of the jobs in business, or 315 jobs. Management positions accounted for 6.5% of business jobs (227 jobs), followed by consulting jobs at 6% (209 jobs).

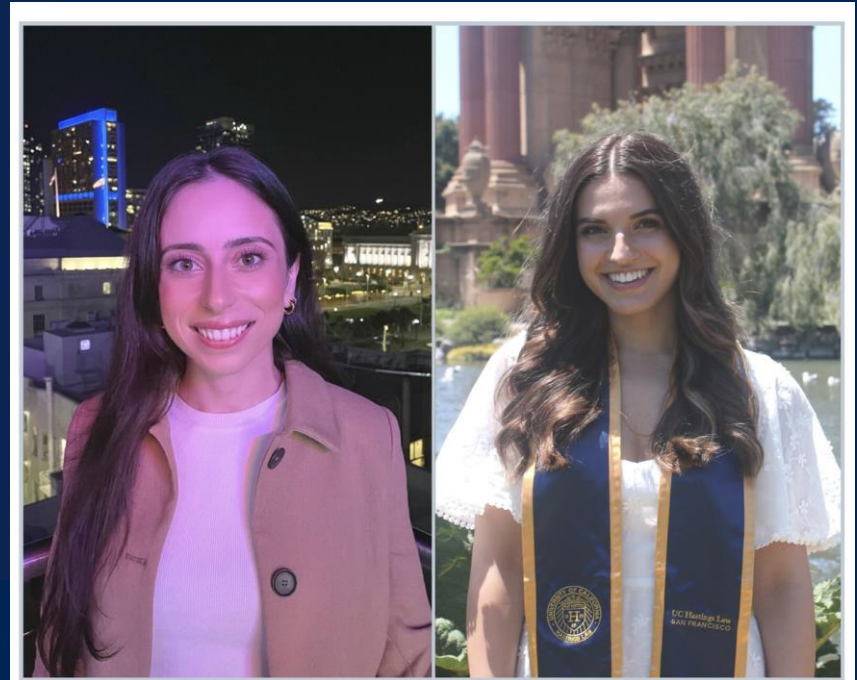
